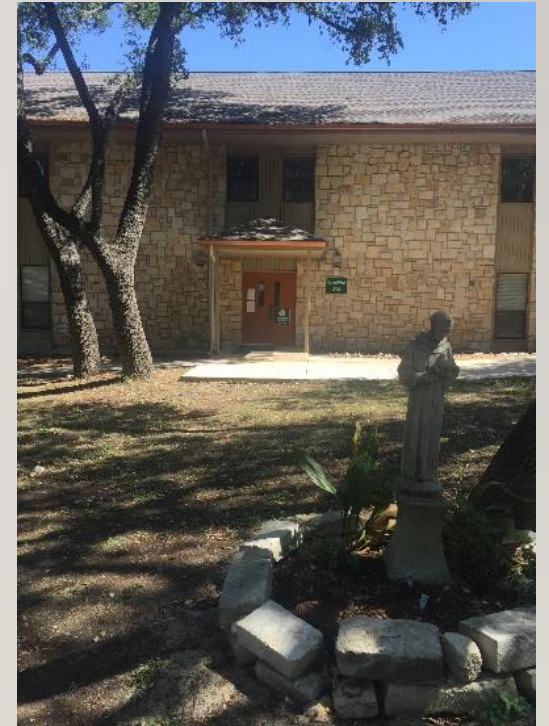
POPULATION

- Roughly a third Asian, a third Middle Eastern, and a third African or other
- Most common languages are Pashto and Burmese
- Most patients use an interpreter (phone or in-person)
- See an average of 10-15 patients per night

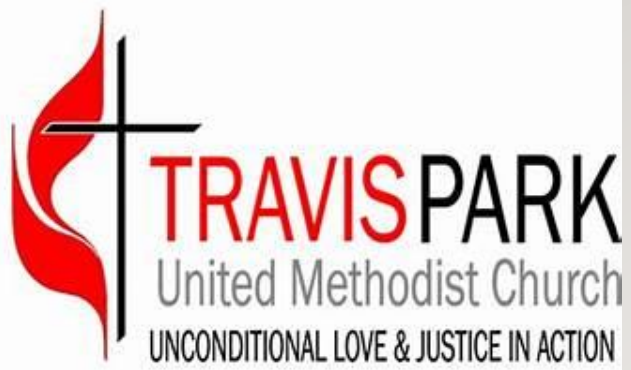
